(Washington, DC)—On December 2nd, Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ) issued the following statement in response to terrorist attacks in Mumbai that have left over 170 dead and hundreds injured:

“I strongly condemn the recent terrorist attacks in Mumbai, India. I remain outraged that these terrible attacks specifically targeted innocent Americans, Jews, and other Westerners and I am deeply saddened by this senseless slaughter, great loss of life, and injuries to both Indians and visitors alike. My thoughts and prayers are with the families around the world who have been affected by these intolerable acts of hatred.

“I strongly urge Pakistan to cooperate with India, the United States, and other allies to hunt down those responsible for these attacks and bring those terrorists to justice. This is another brutal reminder that all countries must work together to combat terrorism. Also, now more than ever, the United States must continue to provide our democratic partners in South Asia with the political, diplomatic, and military support required to defeat terrorists.”
