The Stryker vehicle is the foundation of the Army's Stryker Brigade Combat Teams (SBCTs), which have been deployed eight times to Iraq since the start of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The Stryker Medical Evacuation Vehicle (MEV) has increased survival rates for wounded soldiers with unprecedented mobility, speed, and survivability for a battlefield ambulance. The Stryker MEV also provides large interior space, allowing more

patients, more supplies, and easier access to patients during medical care.
