(Washington, DC)— On Thursday, May 25, Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ) met with Bergen County Academies senior Jiashuo Feng, Fair Lawn, one of 24 finalists for the 2006 U.S. Physics Team. Jiashuo was the only student from New Jersey selected to compete for one of five slots on the U.S. team.
