

Lodi

Lodi, one of 70 towns that comprise Bergen County, is home to nearly 24,000 residents. It was incorporated as a borough on December 22, 1984.

The town holds a number of popular community events each year, including Memorial Day, Fourth of July and Columbus Day Festivities. The community was named for the Bridge of Lodi in Italy where Napoleon Bonaparte gained control of Lombardy by defeating the Austrians at the Battle of Lodi.
