March 14, 2007

More than 50 letter carriers packed into Congressman Rothman's office to thank him for his 100% voting record on important issues to the letter carriers, especially postal reform.

March 13, 2007

Congressman Rothman met with representatives from the New Jersey State Federation of Women's Clubs. The women, who hail from Maywood, North Arlington, Hackensack, Hasbrouck Heights, and Rutherford, thanked Rep. Rothman for his long-time advocacy for full funding of the Violence Against Women Act.

February 18-26, 2007
