

## Rutherford

Rutherford, located in Southern Bergen County, is home to approximately 18,000 residents. The town holds many community events each year, including a Summer Concert Series and movies in Lincoln Park, an annual Farmer's Market, and the annual Labor Day Street Fair, which is the largest in the state and attracts over 20,000 people each year.

Formed by an act of the legislature in 1881, the borough was part of a larger area originally known as Boiling Springs due to the high number of naturally occurring hot springs. The town is home to many historic buildings, including Iviswold Castle on the campus of Felican College, and The William Carlos Williams Center for the Performing Arts, a vaudeville theatre named after the local poet.
